## The Law Amending the Union of Myanmar Co-operative Societies Law, 1970

(The State Law and Order Restoration Council Law No. 11/88)
The 15th Waning Day of *Tazaungmon*, 1350 M.E.
(8th December, 1988)

The State Law and Order Restoration Council hereby enacts the following Law:—

1. This Law shall be called the Law Amending the Union of Myanmar Co-operative Societies Law, 1970.

- 2. In the Union of Myanmar Co-operative Societies Law. 1970:
  - (a) preamble. Section 3, Section 4 sub-section (2), Section 26 sub-section (1), Section 27 sub-sections (3) and (5), Section 28 sub-section (?) and Section 37 sub-section (4) shall be deleted;
  - (b) Section 19 sub-section (2) shall be deleted and sub-section (2) shall be amended as Section 19
  - (c) Section 2 sub-section (1) clause 21 shall be substituted by the following clause:—
    - "21. Auditor means (i) a responsible person or an organization of the Co-operative Department at the various levels, (ii) a person or an organization who/which has been assigned duties by the office of the Union of Myanmar Auditor-General and its offices at the various levels and (iii) a person or an organization who/which has been assigned the duty of auditing the Co-operative Societies by the Government from time to time. "
  - (d) the heading of Chapter II shall be deleted and the heading "Nature of work and Constitution of the Co-operative Societies" shall be substituted;
  - (e) Section 20 sub-section (2) shall be substituted by the following sub-section:—
    "(2) Co-operative Societies may obtain deposits or advances for any enterprise."
  - (f) Section 44 sub-section (2) shall be substituted by the following sub-section:—

"(2) acting contrary to the nature of work mentioned in section 4 xxxx Co-operative Society."
