## The State Law and Order Restoration Council The Law for the (Second Time) Repeal of Laws

(The State Law and Order Restoration Council Law No. 4/93) The 9th Waning Day of Hnaung Tagu, 1354 ME. (31st March, 1993)

Whereas It is expedient to provide for the repeal of certain laws I among existing laws, which on scrutinizing again, have been found to be no longer in conformity with the changing circumstances, laws which have been in use for a long time and laws for which there are no reasons for in future, the State Law and Order Restoration Council hereby enacts Law.

- 1. This Law shall be called the Law for the (Second Time) Repeal of Laws.
- 2. The following laws are hereby repealed; -
  - (a) The Stage Carriages Act.
  - (b) the Pilots Act.
  - (c) The Provident Insurance Societies Act.
  - (d) The Life Assurance Companies Act.
  - (e) The Companies Foreign Interests Act.
  - (f) The Cotton Transport Act.
  - (g) The Contributory Provident Funds Act.
  - (h) The Myanmar Patents and Designs Act, 1945.
  - (I) The Liabilities (Wan Time Adjustment) Act, 1945.
  - (k) The Compassionate Allowance for Aged Members of the Royal Family Act.
  - (I) The Business Premises Tax Act of 1956;
  - (m) The Money- Lenders Law of 1962.
  - (n) The Union of Myanmar Frontier Areas Administration Law of 1962.
