## The Rights of Continued Existence and Registration of Political Party

- 1. For the formation of political parties that set the objective of non-disintegration of the Union, non-disintegration of national solidarity and perpetuation of sovereignty in the Union of Myanmar, that are loyal to the State and that accept and practise a genuine and discipline-flourishing multi-party democratic system, the State Peace and Development Council issued the Political Parties Registration Law under the Law No.2/2010 of the SPDC on 8 March 2010 in accord with the Article-443 of the State Constitution of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar.
- 2. For the formation of political parties, the Union Election Commission issued the Political Parties Registration Bylaws under the Notification No.1/2010 on 17 March 2010.
- 3. Parties that fall within the competence of Political Parties Registration Law Section-25, if they wish to continue their existence may apply at the Union Election Commission Office, Building No.22, Nay Pyi Taw, during office hours as of the date of this announcement issued in accord with the already issued laws and bylaws.
